Measure: 100 additional staff trained in Quality Improvement Methodology per annum

Measure: 80% of wards undertaking CPI projects across NSLHD

Milestone: Safety II initiatives developed and projects on track to achieve key milestones

Milestone: Delivery quarterly education sessions to increase the exposure and understanding of ABF methodology to clinical staff

Milestone: Project milestones and timeframes on-track for successful development of NSLHD Data Lake by June 2019

Measure: Increase in reporting of Aboriginality in admitted patients to > 70%
