



## **CANCER COUNCIL NSW FINANCIAL COUNSELLING SERVICE**

**At the Northern Sydney Cancer Centre, RNSH**

The Northern Sydney Cancer Centre offers a *free* financial counselling through the Cancer Council NSW to assist with managing financial difficulties. Confidential appointments are held here at the Cancer Centre.

### **Who can use the service?**

A person diagnosed with cancer or a primary carer of a person with cancer.

### **How do I make an appointment?**

Speak with your Social Worker, Cancer Nurse Coordinator, Cansupport Service or you can contact the Cancer Helpline on 13 11 20 to book an appointment.

### **What issues can I discuss with the financial counsellor?**

The Counsellor will assess your situation and provide you with options to better manage your financial situation.

This can include: *Budgeting, managing debts/ debt collectors – credit cards, loans etc., mortgage, Centrelink payments, utility bills, fines, bankruptcy, and superannuation.*

### **What do I need to bring for my appointment?**

E.g. Overdue bills, Centrelink statements, legal documents, credit card and bank statements, and other relevant documents.
