Tickets and Passes

Opal cards make travelling on multiple types of public transport easy! Keep it loaded and just tap on and tap off as you travel. Single trip Opal cards can also be purchased from train station ticket machines and bus drivers (except for PrePay buses). Alternatively you can also tap on and tap off with your credit or debit card or linked device using contactless payments.

The closest railway stations are Hornsby and Waitara. Hornsby is accessible via both the main Northern Line (T9) and the North Shore Line (T1). Waitara is on the North Shore Line.



Community Transport

Community transport provides affordable and flexible health and medical transport to eligible individuals who cannot access public transport, including frail aged people over 65 years, people with a disability or a chronic condition and their carers. The service is subject to resource availability.

Bus route 575 travels to Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital from Hornsby and Turramurra railway stations. This picks up and sets down at the front of the Hospital on Palmerston Road. There are no bus services to the Hospital from Waitara Station.



Walking

From Hornsby Station – The distance to the Hospital is approximately 1.8km. If you wish to walk, please note there are a number of hills. Exit the station on the George Street side via the pedestrian overpass.

From Waitara Station – The distance to the Hospital is approximately 1.5km. Exit the station on the Alexandria Avenue side. This walk is reasonably flat.



Cycling

Cycling is an inexpensive, sustainable and healthy way to travel. If you live within 5-10 kilometres of the hospital this can save time and the stress of trying to find parking. Bike racks are located in front of the Mental Health Intensive Care Unit and Emergency entrance. For staff, there is also a secured bike storage facility located in the Hope Building (Building 50). Shower and change facilities are available to staff in the Hope Building and Mental Health Centre. A separate facility for visitors/patients can also be accessed in the Hope Building.



Taxi

Our hospital campus covers a large area so if you are coming by taxi, tell the taxi exactly where you need to be dropped (gates listed on the campus map). Please note that a taxi rank is located at Hornsby Station.
