



eReferrals available for almost 120 clinics at NSLHD from 26 July 2023

Are you using eReferrals yet?

The HealthLink Electronic Referral (eReferral) system in Northern Sydney Local Health District (NSLHD) was introduced in August 2022 and about 130 GP practices have already used eReferrals, **the benefits** they are finding include:

- GPs and practices save time no fax/ emailing is needed, patient and referrer information are pre-filled.
- Patient information is transmitted securely
- GPs receive updates on the progress of the referral through the triage process
- Pathology and imaging reports as well as consultation notes are easily attached
- Automatic checks ensure all necessary information is included

What's happening next?

After another successful launch with 54 clinics on 26th June, another 40 clinics in the e-referral system across the district (see detailed services in the listed table below) will be available from 26th July with the aim to have all clinics available to refer electronically including Allied Health by the end of year.

How to use eReferrals?

HealthLink eReferrals (the same program as the Transport for NSW Fitness to Drive Assessment) are already embedded in compatible software like Best Practice, Medical Director (v3.16), Genie and Medtech Evolution.
