AGENDA ITEMS

The Board held an initial 15 minute in-camera session.

The Board Chair welcomed the Board members and attendees to the meeting and opened the meeting with an acknowledgement of country.

3. Patient Story

3.1. Mental Health Drug and Alcohol – Intellectual Disability, Autism and Mental Health

The Social Worker, Team Lead, Intellectual Disability, Mental Health Drug and Alcohol (MHDA), supported by the, Service Director North Shore Ryde Mental Health Service and the Director Mental Health Drug and Alcohol NSLHD presented an informative patient story illustrating a collaboration of services within the District and the support provided to a challenging case. The presentation identified particular challenges arising where the patient is an adolescent and where decisions by the NDIA are delayed.

4.1. Action List - December 2021

The action list was reviewed and updated accordingly.

4.2. Real Time Patient Experience Survey

The Director Clinical Governance and Patient Experience (DCG&PE) provided an overview of the Real Time Patient Experience Survey (RTPES). The presentation included the benefits and the concept of the survey. The DCG&PE explained the response methodology and the use of a 'net promoter score'. Examples of responses received so far were provided. Questions were asked and answered on issues that included privacy and confidentiality, and availability to non-English speakers. The project is now in the second phase of implementation. Further focus to refining the questions being asked in the survey.

Action: DCG&PE to provide an update at the July 2022 meeting.

5. Chief Executive update on COVID-19 activities

The Chief Executive (CE) provided a verbal update with the following highlights:

- Numbers of COVID-19 patients in hospital is stabilising.
- · Number of furloughed staff is improving.



- Most COVID-19 operational changes have reverted back with Emergency Department (ED) pathways remaining in place.
- The District will continue to focus on improving the rate of booster vaccinations with social media campaigns.
- Booster vaccinations may need to be co-ordinated with Winter flu vaccinations later in the year.
- The District will start to close some swabbing clinics while ensuring coverage in all areas of the region.
- Metropolitan public hospitals remain on restricted surgery, Category A and Emergencies only.
- Plans have been prepared for recommencing surgery when advised by the Ministry of Health (MoH).

6. Update on Accreditation

The National Safety and Quality Health Service Accreditation Manager (NSQHSAM) NSLHD provided an overview of Accreditation Assessments including revised assessment dates and the preparations being undertaken for the 2022 accreditations of Ryde Hospital, Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital (HKH), Royal North Shore Hospital (RNSH) and the Primary and Community Health service. The NSQHSAM advised of the challenges and risks currently being faced.

The A/Executive Director Operations, NSLHD provided an overview of the preparations and progress of the Ryde Hospital Accreditation Assessment, scheduled for March 2022.

The Board Chair thanked the team involved in preparing the hospitals and service for the accreditation assessments and the significant effort that has been put into preparing Ryde Hospital.

- The Women in Medical Leadership Committee is progressing with five work groups currently progressing ideas.
- The Board Chair and Deputy Board Chair will attend Ryde Hospital this week for a walkaround.
- The NSW Health Secretary has resigned after six years in the position.
- The Board Chair attended an extraordinary meeting of the Finance Risk and Performance (FRAP) Committee to discuss the financial position of RNSH hospital.
- Members of the Board and NSLHD Executive met with Microsoft to look at what can be implemented to enhance the digital capabilities of patients and the community.
- There will be a focus in the District this year to work to enhance the adherence to CORE values.
