- The community vaccination rates in the District are very high.

- The Ministry of Health (MoH) has advised planned surgery can recommence starting at 50 per cent capacity, slowly increasing to 75 per cent.
- The District is working on strategy and operational changes to assist with living with COVID-19 in the community on an ongoing basis.
- Staff wellbeing is a priority. The District is working to manage excess leave.
