Mandatory referral information

All MDPU referrals must include a treating consultant accredited at RNSH.

All referrals must include patient's details including a telephone number, diagnosis, urgency of treatment and the impact on the patient, and any significant medical history and relevant social information.

All Infusion referrals must have a current medication chart, consent form and any script required. This will assist us to triage the referral and provide an appointment without delay.

MDPU does not provide cytotoxic infusion service.

Patients Criteria

All Patients referred to MDPU must be over 18 years of age.

Please provide a Care Plan and discuss with Nurse Unit Manager if your patient will be attending MDPU without a carer or support person and has special care requirements. For example, mobility issues communication limitations or continence issues.

The Care Plan will ensure that MDPU staff are able to appropriately plan and care for patients with special needs.
