RNSH Criteria	
Age	30 - 50
30 – 39	MRI and Ultrasound
40 – 49	MRI and MMG +/- Ultrasound

<sup>\*</sup>current eviQ guidelines state 35yo is the minimum age, however this project started prior to the publication of eviQ

<sup>\*\* ?</sup> higher risk for women in 30-34 age range suspected

Westmead Criteria	
Age	30 - 50
30 – 39	initial MMG and U/S then only MRI annually until 40
40 – 49	MMG, U/S and MRI annually

Recent practice change in keeping with guidelines that say women under 40 don't need MMG.

MRI's cease at 50 as by then the MMG are easier to read as breast tissue is less dense and also the incidence of BRCA is lessened.
